


THE PROGRAM REPORT OF CENTER FOR JEWISH EDUCATION ACTIVITY IN 2019

She emphasized the significance and importance of this edition for development of polycultural education in Ukraine, paid attention to the wide genre palette of translations into the Ukrainian language of fairy-tales, parables, jokes, legends, and myths of Ukrainians, Crimean Tatars, Krymchaks, Karaites, Romanians, Hungarians, Poles, Bulgarians, Russians, Greeks, Moldovans, Gagauz people, Jews, Roms, Slovaks and other ethnos of Ukraine.

In the opinion of the spokesperson, the selected literary works will promote deeper acquaintance with the national and cultural specificities and values, formation of intercultural knowledge and civil unity, bringing up tolerant behaviour of young readers, personal enrichment.

In summer 2019 the book was kindly presented by the «Bukrek» Publishing House to the Center for Jewish Education of Ukraine for further free distribution among the participants of children's and youth projects «Shorashim» and «The Sources of Tolerance».

For the first time in the period of March 27 - April 2, 2019, Israel became a location of the international seminar of advanced training for educators, presenters and leaders of nonformal Jewish education organized by the Center for Jewish Education of Ukraine with the support of the Youth Movement HaKhalutz LeMirkhav in cooperation with the Jewish National foundation Keren Kaemet leIsrael, the World Zionist Congress and the Israel Experience company for Jewish Agency for Israel «Sokhnut».

Participants of the seminar were coordinators and methodologists of educational projects in the sphere of non-formal Jewish education, programme directors, methodologists and presenters of the International Jewish camp for children «Shorashim» - «The Roots and Future for Jews in Diaspora» in Ukraine and Georgia, presenters of programmes for children and youth for the Jewish Community Center «Khalom».

On May 24, 2019, there was a ceremony of awarding students of institutions of education of Kyiv who became the winners of the 3rd stage of The All-Ukrainian Student Olympiad in the Hebrew language with diplomas of the Department of education and science of Kyiv city council directorate (Kyiv city state administration). The awardees were the students of 9th -11th grades of school №299 of the Obolon district of Kyiv, school №141 «ORT» and secondary school №325 «Happiness» of the Dniprovskiy district of Kyiv.

The awarding ceremony was prepared and conducted by the organizers of the event - Irina Kuzmenchuk, the methodologist of the scientific and Methodological Center of Humanitarian Education and Upbringing of the Institute of Postgraduate Pedagogical Education of the Kyiv Boris Hrynchenko University, and Nataliia Bakulina, PhD in education, the head of the Center for Jewish Education of Ukraine, senior research associate of the Department of teaching the languages of national minorities and foreign literature of the Institute of Pedagogy of the Academy of Pedagogical Sciences of Ukraine.

Dates of conducting the event: 16-20 June 2019.

The venue: Israel

Geography of participants:

Participants of the international seminar were the educators from Moldova, Russia, Tatarstan, Ukraine and Estonia, as well as their Israeli colleagues.

Ukraine was represented by extensive geography of participants and human resources potential of educators both from research and educational structures and institutions of the communal and private property, formal and non-formal secondary and tertiary education. In particular, the seminar had the following audience: representatives of the Center for Jewish Education of Ukraine (Kyiv), Private academic complex «Comprehensive schools of I - III stages – kindergarten «Mitzva-613» (Bila Tserkva), The «Khabad» academic unit (Kherson), Zaporizhya Sunday Jewish School «Yakhad Maccabee» (Zaporizhya), the Institute of Pedagogy of the NAPS of Ukraine (Kyiv), the International Humanitarian Teacher-training Institute «Beit-Khana» (Dnipro), the Zionist Federation of Ukraine (Kyiv), CF «Life Changer» (Kyiv).

The aims and tasks of the seminar:

- To introduce participants to the systems of formal and non-formal education and innovative methodologies in Israel;
- To introduce the experience and activities of both the directorate of education in diaspora of the Department of education and community Keren Kaemet le Israel for Jewish National Foundation and the Foundation in general;
- To test the educational materials, developed by KKI-JNF for further use in teaching activity in diaspora, bringing up new generation on the basics of emotional-evaluating, personality-oriented and competence approaches to teaching and education;
- To enhance the level of professional competence of the seminar participants for enriching their pedagogical experience, personal growth, broadening their polycultural outlook, development of

their leadership skills and strengthening international cooperation in implementation of educational projects for future generations.

Forms of work at the seminar:

During the seminar for participants the following events were organized: educational excursions, meetings and round-table talks in pedagogical centers, museums, universities, discussions, lectures, educational workshops, creative studios and cultural programme.

Results: In the process of the seminar the participants not only got acquainted with the system of formal and non-formal education Israel, best practices and activity KKI-JNF, innovative methodologies and upgraded their personal and professional level, but also shared their best practices and told about their activity at the venues, mad speeches and talks, presented the interim results of their research, exchanged experience and established partnership. Creative, tolerant and vibrant atmosphere of the seminar made participants create their own mini-projects, which they will be able to implement with their pupils / students further on.

As a result, the participants received official certificates from the seminar organizers.

However, this was not just a customary seminar. It was a seminar-travel, a seminar-training course, the agenda of which was logically and competently built up and structured. Everything was thought out to the last detail – from logistics to the balanced theoretical and practical content. 5 days before the seminar the participants visited 28 cultural and educational locations in various regions of Israel. This was an incredible itinerary - Tel-Aviv, Agmon ha-Khula, Kfar Nakhum, Kfar Kedem, Nazareth, Natzrat-Illit, Safed, Jerusalem, Jaffa.

During these days the participants enjoyed an extremely busy and interesting programme, thoroughly prepared by the organizers of the event. Each day was unique and unforgettable – full of interesting, polycultural, creative, delicious, caring, multi-language activities (the classes were conducted in Polish (with translation), Ukrainian and Russian languages with fragments in Hebrew, Yiddish and English)!

The project agenda included educational, creative and entertainment blocks, in particular educational classes, creative workshops, hiking in the mountains, intellectual and active games, watching films, excursions, preparation and conducting Sabbath, and of course interesting communication.

The Educational block consisted of didactic classes in history and wisdom of Tanah and the leading topic of Jerusalem, connections between various Jewish communities of diaspora and Israel. In the interesting and interactive form the participants were learning the values of Jewish people via classical texts, got to know about the historical development of Jerusalem of various epochs and its meaning for various religions, its archaeological and cultural values and landmarks, the Old City Gates and new residential areas as well as their residents, ancient and contemporary means of transportation, modern cultural and topical events, international connections, as well as specificities of contemporary system of education in Israel.

During the creative block the kids took part in master-classes in making magnets, bags and decorations with the help of various techniques as well as kneading dough and baking challahs for Sabbath and making a panel picture dedicated to the history of Jerusalem.

During the project we also had exciting hikes and excursions around the Jewish landmarks of Poland, meetings in the Jewish community of the towns of Katowice and Tychy.

Also during the project there was a meeting with the head of the Jewish organization «Beitar» that now operates in Warsaw and basically works in monitoring and opposition to antisemitism.

Strategic aim of the project: development of didactic modules for the academic programme of advanced training in theory and methodology of teaching disciplines of Jewish Studies for pedagogical community, experts and applicants of formal, non-formal and informal education, figures of science and culture.

Target audience of the project: the teachers of Hebrew, history, tradition, art, music for Jewish people at didactic institutions of Ukraine, tutors and musical directors of pre-school educational institutions with Jewish ethnic and cultural component, presenters and heads of educational programmes of cultural and education centers and projects of non-formal Jewish education, in particular, clubs and youth camps, the heads of educational institutions and cultural and educational programmes, students, scholars and connoisseurs of culture, research and professional activity related to Jewish Studies, a wide circle of interested experts willing to upgrade their knowledge of Jewish research sphere for further academic, scientific, cultural and artistic activity, implementation of research projects in the sphere of Ukrainian-Jewish relations, development of integrated educational programmes and academic methodological complexes in the arts and humanitarian disciplines, revealing the specificities of mutual penetration and influence of the Ukrainian and Jewish cultures.

The aims and tasks of the project:

- To analyse normative documents, methodological guidelines, professional scientific, research and methodological literature related to challenges of the project;
- To study the condition of making solutions for coping with the challenges in contemporary Ukrainian and international academic practice;
- To select the content of didactic modules academic programme;
- To define criteria of the level of forming professional competences in accordance with this or that academic module:
- To develop educational modules on profile and elective courses of the academic programme of advanced training of educators, experts and applicants of formal, non-formal and informal education, figures of science and culture, in particular:
 - «Jewish education в Ukraine and the world: history and modernity»,
 - «Methodology of teaching disciplines in Jewish Studies»,
 - «Traditional culture for Jewish people»,
 - «Traditional Jewish musical art»,
 - «History of Jewish people»,
 - «Implementation of competence approach in Hebrew classes»,
 - «The history of Holocaust on the territory of Ukraine»,
 - «Babiy Yar: memory on the background of history»,
 - «Non-formal Jewish education»,
 - «Class as a social group»;
- To test and experimentally check the efficiency of particular topics of the developed didactic modules in organization of academic, scientific, cultural and artistic activities in terms of the pilot projects.



Results: Tested and corrected content of didactic modules of the academic programme of advanced training courses was prepared for accreditation at MoES of Ukraine and submitted for consideration of the Commission of Postgraduate Education of the Scientific and Methodological Council for Education of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine with the aim of obtaining corresponding approval and further use in the process of organizing training courses of advanced training, what will allow the participants to obtain official documents for confirmation and upgrading categories while undergoing attestation and certification of experts in accordance with the new Law of Ukraine «About Education» as well as other statutory and regulatory documents.
